MINISTRY UPDATES: Jana, Dennis and Shannon returned from a rewarding trip to Africa. We were able to visit with all of the girls in the House of Love as well as meet 9 new girls! Most of the girls knew us from our last trip so they opened up right away. We also met Pastor John's new wife, Joyce. She has moved into the Director's house with John and her two children, and they are already part of the House of Love family. Finally, we met with the staff to learn about their needs. We found out that Leshuta is getting



electricity! Once installed, it will greatly improve life in this remote part of Africa.

HOUSE OF LOVE NEEDS: I want to let you know about some needs that we learned about from the staff at the House of Love:

Mattresses: \$950.00 The girls still have the mattresses from when the orphanage was built.

Blankets: \$225.00 This would give each girl a brand-new blanket.

Fence Extension: \$825.00 The town of Leshuta donated more land to the House of Love, and we need to fence that in. We are going to use the new land to plant fruit trees.

Irrigation: \$125.00 The corn fields are partially irrigated, and we need to finish that project so they don't lose any crops and can extend their cornfields.

Electricity: \$1,200 This is the cost to bring the electricity into the orphanage, the kitchen, and the director's house.

Since Leshuta just got electricity, we thought this would be a great opportunity for a money-making project for the House of Love. If we purchase an electric corn crusher, and we build a permanent structure on the HOL property (near the entrance), the staff can charge Leshuta residents to crush their corn into flour. The HOL would have the only corn crusher in the area. The closest one is in Naikarra which is a day's walk. This project would help with our goal of making the House of Love more self-sufficient.
